

## McKinney-Vento Education Program: Student Rights & Questionnaire

- The federal McKinney-Vento Act protects the rights of children and youths in *homeless situations* (a temporary housing situation, who are facing a housing hardship) to attend and succeed in school.
- The McKinney-Vento Act applies to all children and youths who **do not have a** *fixed*, *regular, and adequate residence*, including those who are staying with friends or relatives because they have lost their housing; are awaiting foster care placement; or are living in emergency or transitional shelters, motels, domestic violence shelters, campgrounds, inadequate trailer parks, cars, public spaces, abandoned buildings, or bus and train stations.

### Student Rights- Children and youths in homeless situations have the right to:

- ➢ Go to school, no matter where they live or how long they have lived there.
- Choose the local school where they are now living, the school they attended before they lost their housing, or the school where they were last enrolled.
- Enroll in school without immunization, school records, proof of residency, or birth certificates and other such documents.
- > Be provided with transportation to and from school.
- > Be free from harassment and isolation.
- > Access to Title I and other educational programs to the same extent as other students.
- > Have any disagreements with the school settled quickly.

\*The McKinney-Vento Education Act is a federal law; therefore, it supersedes all state laws and school district policies. This law does not recognize school district, county or state borders.
